

CHOOSE 2 ACTIVITIES

Dear parents, please choose any 2 of these activities each week for your child to do. They may be done on any kind of paper from home. Please write the 2 chosen activities on the first page. (2 must be written ~~and one can be hands-on~~) If you choose to do activities like delicious words or muddy words, I would love to see it! Please snap a picture and email it to me! These are due with your child's reading log by the following Friday. The activities may all come back on Thursday if they finish early.

ABC Order- put all spelling words in alphabetical order.

Word Search – make and complete a word search using all words

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Sentences – use 10 words in a sentence. (You may use up to three words in one sentence.)

Rhyming Words – make a list of rhyming words for each of your spelling words.

Original Story – write your own creative story using 10 –12 Spelling words.

Poem – use at least ten Spelling words in your own poem

Definitions – write the definition of 10 words

Rainbow Spelling - write each of your words in 3- 5 different colors.

Illustrations - Illustrate and label each of your words.

Synonyms(same)/Antonyms(opposite) - Write a synonym or antonym for 10 words. List under Synonym or Antonym.

Backwards Words- Write 10 words forwards, then backwards.

Picture words – Draw a picture and write your words in the picture.

Colorful Vowels – Write ALL your words coloring all vowels.

Colorful Consonants – Same as above but color all consonants.

Ransom words – Write 10 words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and glue them on a paper.

Pyramid Words – Write your words adding or subtracting one letter at a time. The result will be a pyramid shape of words.

Delicious words – Write your words in whipped cream, peanut butter, or anything you can eat! Bring in a note from a parent!

Good Clean Words -Write your words in shaving cream on a counter or some other surface that can be cleaned safely. Bring me a note from a parent

Muddy Words – Write your words in mud or sand. Bring me a note from a parent

3D words – Use modeling clay rolled thinly to make your words. Bring a note if done at home.

X Words – Write two words having one common letter so they criss-cross. Do all words.

Other Handed – If you are right-handed, write with your left, or vice versa
